WJA High Pressure Water Jetting Course

At the start of the year, CISTC introduced **WJA** High Pressure Water Jetting as a new course delivered at our centre in partnership with Jetmasters Ltd.



IN PARTNERSHIP WITH



The Water Jetting Association (WJA) is the main provider of water jetting training in the UK.



The entry-level course is Water Jetting Safety Awareness. This is a mandatory one-day class-based course covering all main areas of water jetting operation and safety, including types of water jetting, water pressure and flow rates, risk assessment, and the use of safety clothing. At the end of the course, delegates must pass a 20-question multiple choice questionnaire. The Water Jetting Safety Awareness course must be retaken every three years to retain registration with the WJA. We strongly recommend that operatives should combine the Water Jetting Safety Awareness course with a relevant practical course to

obtain the most thorough instruction in safe and effective water jetting.

Practical Water Jetting Training

If the Water Jetting Safety Awareness course is successfully completed, candidates can learn hands-on skills by attending specific training courses that include practical instruction.

These are:

- Drain and Sewer Cleaning (half day)
- Surface Preparation (half day)
- Tube and Pipe Cleaning (half day)
- Hydrodemolition (full day)
- We also offer a standalone full day Pressure Washing course.



Benefits for operatives:

- Successful candidates are registered with the WJA international database.
- Successful candidates are issued with a certificate and a WJA photo-ID card, detailing courses passed.
- WJA water jetting training is recognised by employers and is required by many contractors.

- It supports safe, productive and sustainable water jetting practice
- It supports workforce development and key operative retention
- It provides quality assurance for prospective customers.

SiteRight—Cable Avoidance

This course was developed in conjunction with Leica Geosystems, one of the leading cable avoidance equipment manufacturers in the world. Leica Geosystems provide the Train the Trainer course for all trainers wishing to offer this course.


